Earlier today, the President signed the “Cromnibus” legislation that included a provision mandating USDA return potatoes to the program within 15 days of the bill’s passage and approval (signature) by the President. Just as important was the grass roots efforts of the National Potato Council and the volunteer industry leaders who dedicated their time and money to make this happen.
