AN ACT

RELATING TO THE IDAHO POTATO COMMISSION; AMENDING SECTION 22-1202, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE IDAHO POTATO COMMISSION SHALL SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE GOVERNOR, TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO STATISTICS, TO REMOVE CERTAIN MAPPING PROVISIONS, TO PROVIDE FOR RULEMAKING, AND TO REVISE TERM OF OFFICE PROVISIONS; AMENDING SECTION 22-1204, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE DEFINITIONS; AMENDING CHAPTER 12, TITLE 22, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 22-1201A, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE DESIGNATION OF VOTING REPRESENTATIVES AND TO PROVIDE THAT DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVES MAY VOTE ON ONLY ONE BALLOT IN ANY ELECTION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 22-1202, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

22-1202. POTATO COMMISSION CREATED. There is hereby created and established in the department of self-governing agencies the "Idaho potato commission" to be composed of nine (9) practical potato persons, resident citizens of the state of Idaho for a period of three (3) years prior to their appointment, each of whom has had active experience in growing, or shipping, or processing of potatoes produced in the state of Idaho. At least five (5) members of said commission shall be growers who are actually now engaged in the production of potatoes. Two (2) of the members shall be shippers who are actually now engaged in the shipping of potatoes, and two (2) of the members shall be processors who are actually now engaged in the processing of potatoes. The qualifications for members of said commission as above required shall continue throughout their respective terms of office, and members shall serve at the pleasure of the governor. Three (3) growers shall be nominated for each grower vacancy that occurs, from which the governor shall appoint one (1). Two (2) grower commissioners shall be appointed from the district known as District No. 1, consisting of the counties of Oneida, Franklin, Bear Lake, Caribou, Bannock, Power, Bingham, Bonneville, Teton, Madison, Jefferson, Fremont, Clark, and Butte; and one (1) grower commissioner shall be appointed from the district known as District No. 2B, consisting of the counties of Twin Falls, Jerome, Lincoln, Cassia, Blaine, Boise, Valley, and Gooding; one (1) grower commissioner shall be appointed from the district known as District No. 2B, consisting of the counties of Custer, Minidoka, Payette, Canyon, and Lemhi; and one (1) grower commissioner shall be appointed from the district known as District No. 3, consisting of the counties of Owyhee, Ada, Canyon, Gem, Payette, Washington, Adams, Idaho, Lewis, Nez Perce, Clearwater, Latah, Bingham, Shoshone, Bonneville, Benewah, and Boundary. Three (3) shippers shall be nominated for each shipper vacancy that occurs, from which the governor shall appoint one

1 (1). Shipper commissioners do not necessarily need to be nominated from geographical areas. Three (3) successors shall be nominated for each position
 2 vacancy that occurs, from which the governor shall appoint one (1). Process-
 3 tor commissioners do not necessarily need to be nominated from geographical
 4 areas. Nominations must be made thirty (30) days prior to appointment. All
 5 nominations must give equal consideration to all who are eligible for ap-
 6 pointment as defined in this act. The administrative commission held
 7 hearings meeting(s) of the grower, shippers, or processors, as the adminis-
 8 trative commission determines who
 9 shall be nominated for appointment. Notice of said meeting shall be given
 10 by publication in one (1) newspaper published in each county where said
 11 established in which said nomination is to be made, and the notice shall be
 12 published in two (2) issues of each newspaper the first being approximately
 13 forty (40) days and the second approximately ten (10) days before said meet-
 14 ing. The notice shall state the purpose, time and place of said hearing. And
 15 notwithstanding the selection of nominees shall be held prior to March 31 of
 16 the year the appointment or appointment is to be made. The commission shall
 17 after filing for nominating commissioners in some or the commission.
 18

19 The term of office shall be three (3) years and no commissioner shall
 20 serve more than two (2) consecutive terms. The commissioners shall elect a
 21 chairman for a term of one (1) year.

22 Vacancies shall be filled as vacancies occur. Both of our commissioners
 23 shall hold office until his successor has been appointed and qualified. The
 24 term of office shall commence on September 15 of the year of appointment and
 25 expire on September 14 ~~August~~ 31 of the last year of the term of office.

26 A majority of the members of said commission shall constitute a quorum
 27 for the transaction of all business and the carrying out of the duties of said
 28 commission. Before entering on the discharge of their duties as members of
 29 said commission, each member shall take and subscribe to the oath of office
 30 prescribed for state officers.

31 Each member of the commission shall be compensated as provided by sec-
 32 tion 59-505(4), Idaho Code, provided however, that compensation paid to mem-
 33 bers of the commission from and after April 1, 1992, shall no longer be considered
 34 salary as defined in section 59-302(3)(b), Idaho Code.

35 SECTION 2. That Section 22-1204, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
 36 amended to read as follows:

37 22-1204. DEFINITIONS. As used in this act:

38 1. The term "commission" means the Idaho potato commission.

39 2. The term "person" means individual, partnership, corporation, associa-
 40 tion, grower and/or any other business unit.

41 3. The term "potatoes" means and includes only potatoes sold or in
 42 tended for human consumption and grown in the state of Idaho.

43 4. "Shipment" of potatoes shall be deemed to take place when the pota-
 44 toes are loaded within the state of Idaho, in a car, bulk, truck or other con-
 45 voyance in which the potatoes are to be transported for sale or otherwise.

46 5. The term "dealer" means and includes any person engaged in the busi-
 47 ness of buying, receiving, processing, or selling potatoes for profit or re-
 48萌nivation.

4 6. The term "shipper" means and includes one who is properly licensed
 2 under federal and state law and actively engaged in the packing and ship-
 3 ping of potatoes in the primary channel of trade in interstate commerce in
 4 the state of Idaho, and who ships more than he produces.

5 7. The term "grower" means one who is actively engaged in the production
 6 of farm products, primarily potatoes, and who is not engaged in the shipping
 7 or marketing of potatoes:

- 8 (a) Is actively engaged in the production of potatoes in the state of
 9 Idaho and derives a substantial portion of his income therefrom;
- 10 (b) is not primarily engaged in the shipping or processing of potatoes;
- 11 (c) Grows potatoes on five (5) or more acres; and
- 12 (d) has been actively engaged in growing potatoes in the state of Idaho
 13 for a period of at least three (3) years prior to nomination and has paid
 14 for a period of at least three (3) years prior to nomination and has paid
 15 assessments to the commission on potatoes in each of the preceding three
 16 (3) calendar years.

17 8. Potatoes shall be deemed to be delivered into the primary channel of
 18 trade when any such potatoes are sold or delivered for shipment, or delivered
 19 for canning and/or processing into by products.

20 9. The term "hundredweight" means each one hundred (100) pound unit or
 21 combination of packages making a one hundred (100) pound unit of any shipment
 22 of potatoes based on invoice and/or bill of lading records.

23 10. The term "processor" means a person who is actively engaged in the
 24 processing of potatoes in Idaho for human consumption and transacting business
 25 within the state of Idaho.

26 11. The term "processing" means changing the form of potatoes from the
 27 raw or natural state into a product for human consumption.

28 12. The term "handler" means and includes any person processing pota-
 29 toes or handling them in the primary channel of trade.

30 13. The term "tax" means an assessment levied on potatoes covered by
 31 this act for the sole purpose of financing, on behalf of the potato industry
 32 in Idaho, the commission's activities in carrying out the purposes of this
 33 act.

34 SECTION 3. That Chapter 12, Title 22, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
 35 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and de-
 36 nominated as Section 22-1204A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

37 22-1204A. DESIGNATION OF VOTING REPRESENTATIVES -- VOT-MC. (1) Each
 38 grower entity shall designate annually its voting representative to the com-
 39 mission for commissioner nominations. Designated representatives may vote
 40 on only one (1) ballot in any election.

41 (2) Each shipper entity shall designate annually its voting repre-
 42 sentative to the commission for commissioner nominations. Designated repre-
 43 sentatives may vote on only one (1) ballot in any election.

44 (3) Each processor entity shall designate annually its voting repre-
 45 sentative to the commission for commissioner nominations. Designated rep-
 46 resentatives may vote on only one (1) ballot in any election.

47 SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefore, which emergency is hereby
 48 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
 49 passage and approval.
