RULEMAKING TO BEGIN ON SETBACK REQUIREMENTS FOR AGRICULTURAL WASTE STORAGE

Boise - The Idaho State Department of Agriculture (ISDA) is seeking public input on a new rule establishing setback distances for agricultural waste storage. The new rule is intended to apply to agricultural waste storage on property that is <u>not</u> a beef cattle animal feeding operation or dairy.
