Over the past three weeks, I've participated with the Idaho State Department of Agriculture and USDA APHIS in Bi-lateral negotiations with Japan and Korea. Our aim has been to restore export eligibility for Idaho® potatoes to these two countries. I'm pleased to report that we have made progress with both countries in our efforts to reopen these markets. There are remaining technical issues to resolve, but we are on a good path.

I also attended the US/Canada Potato Committee meeting in early November. You have seen the Press Release jointly issued by the National Potato Council and the Canadian Horticulture Council outlining the results of that meeting. I believe that this meeting marked the first time that the industry representatives from both countries actually grappled with and brokered an agreement regarding a serious problem, PCN. It is now our responsibility on both sides of the border to work to ensure that our governments implement what industry has agreed to.
